No claim for refund of the fee will be entertained nor will it be held in reserve for any other examination.

N.B.: There shall be no 'Edit Window' after closure of online submission of application. The applicants are advised to verify the details provided in the online application form very carefully. They are advised to identify incorrect entry, if any and edit the same. It may be noted that once 'Final Submission' button is clicked, the system will not allow editing of any field further. No request for any correction/change would be entertained after submission of application form.

Prior to clicking of 'Final Submission' button the applicants are therefore requested to be sure that all information furnished are correct and edit any field if required.

Guidelines popped-up during filling up of online application form should be followed continuously.

I N F O R M A T I O N

1. SUBMISSION OF MORE THAN ONE APPLICATION FOR THE POST BY THE SAME CANDIDATE IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN AND SUCH APPLICATIONS ARE LIABLE TO CANCELLATION.
2. The qualifications prescribed in the advertisement are as per the notified recruitment rules issued by Government.
3. All the degrees/diplomas/certificates mentioned in the advertisement must have been obtained from Universities/Institutions, duly recognized by competent authority.
4. The prescribed qualifications are the bare minimum and mere possession of the same does not entitle applicants to be called for the interview. If the number of applications received in response to the advertisement is large and it is not conveniently possible for the Commission to interview all the applicants, the Commission may restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable limit on the basis of either higher qualifications/ higher marks/grade obtained in the essential qualifications or experience in relevant field higher than the minimum prescribed in the advertisement or on the basis of a **Screening Test**.

Note I: Commission has fixed the following qualifying marks in Interview:

The Commission will however, have the liberty of further relaxing the qualifying marks, if sizeable numbers of posts in reserved category remain unfilled.

Note II: Marks obtained in Screening Test will not be considered for preparation of Merit List for recommendation. Marks obtained in the Screening Test will only be considered for selection of candidates for interview for the purpose of restricting the number of candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable limit.

Note III: After display of Model Answers (MCQ Type) in the PSC website, objections by the candidates need to be filed strictly within the specific time limit, beyond which no objection shall be entertained.

Note IV: In the Screening Test, Tie-Breaking amongst same marks is not applied. Instead, all eligible candidates securing cut-off marks i.e., same marks with the last candidate in respective category will be called to interview. This may invite a large number of candidates to be called for interview for a particular category compared to other categories.

However, if same marks is obtained in the interview by two or more candidates, preference would be given to seniors by virtue of date of birth in course of recommendation. If dates of birth are found same, higher percentage of marks in the examination meant for minimum academic qualification required for the post would be given priority in seniority.

Provisions regarding PwBD candidates:

In case of Screening Test, Candidates having Benchmark Disabilities with limitation in writing including that of speed may be allowed the help of Scribe, if required. For convenience, PwBD candidates are requested to bring their own Scribe (wherever applicable). The Scribe should possess educational qualification one step below the qualification of the candidate taking examination. The Person with Benchmark Disabilities opting for own scribe should submit details of the own scribe as per Proforma supplied by the Commission at the time of examination. In case of category of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities, the provisions of scribe can be allowed on production of a certificate to the effect that the person concerned has physical limitation to write, and scribe is essential to write examination on his behalf, from the Chief Medical Officer/Medical Superintendent of a Government health care institution as per Proforma at APPENDIX-I (Available at the end of this advertisement). The facility of Scribe would be allowed to any Person with Benchmark Disability as defined under section 2(r) of the RPwD Act, 2016 and has limitation in writing including that of speed. In case Persons with Benchmark Disabilities in the category of Blindness, Locomotor Disability (both arms affected– BA) and cerebral palsy, the facility of scribe shall be given, if so desired by the person. Engagement of scribe shall not be accepted after final submission of the application.

Candidates with Benchmark Disabilities having limitation in writing including that of speed and producing valid Appendix-I, will be allowed compensatory time of 20 minutes per hour.

5. In cases where no Division/Class is awarded and only grading is done, exact percentage of marks and conversion formula adopted are to be mentioned with documentary evidence, if required.
6. Where experience of a number of years is prescribed as an item of qualification this would mean only experience/research experience gained in full time employment/research in the relevant field within the closing date of receipt of applications.

[Certificate(s) from the Head(s) of the Organization(s)/Department(s) or Competent Authority for the entire experience claimed, clearly mentioning the duration of employment (date, month and year) and field of experience indicating basic pay and consolidated pay must be obtained. The certificate(s) should also mention the nature of duties performed/experience obtained in the post(s) with duration(s)].

7. A candidate would be considered as well-qualified if his/her educational qualification is at least one level higher than the essential requirement. A candidate may be treated as 'Well-experienced' if he/she has at least 2 (two) completed years of experience in excess of the experience in the area of expertise advertised. The extent of age relaxation will not exceed 5 (five) years in any case.
8. Besides pay, the posts carry allowances as admissible.
9. The benefits of upper age concession up to 5 years are admissible only to S.C. and S.T. candidates of West Bengal and up to 3 years to O.B.C. (category 'A' & 'B') (non creamy layer) candidates of West Bengal. S.C., S.T. and O.B.C. candidates of other States may apply for unreserved vacancies as general candidates. Such benefits are also available up to the age of 45 years for Persons with benchmark disabilities.

Ex- servicemen who have put in not less than six months' continuous service in any rank (whether as a combatant or non-combatant) in the Armed Forces of the union shall be allowed to deduct the period of such service from his/her actual age and if the resultant age does not exceed the maximum age limit prescribed for the post (i.e. 40 years) by more than 3 (three) years, he/she shall be deemed to have satisfied the condition regarding age limit.

10. A candidate claiming to be EWS (Economically Weaker Section), S.C., S.T., O.B.C. (non creamy layer), Persons with benchmark disabilities (40% and above), Ex-serviceman or Meritorious Sports Persons must have a certificate in support of his/her claim from a competent authority of West Bengal as specified below:

(a) For EWS candidates:

The benefit of reservation under EWS category can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by any of the following authorities in prescribed format as given in Annexure - C:

- i) Additional District Magistrate in charge of development matter of the District concerned.
- ii) District Welfare Officer, Kolkata and Ex-officio Joint Director, BCW & TD in respect of Kolkata covering the jurisdiction of the Kolkata Municipal corporation.

[In terms of PAR Department Memo. No. 325-PAR(AR)/3P-1/2019 dated 09.07.2019 read with BCW Department Memo No. 959-BCW/MR-52/2019 dated 08.05.2023. However, any EWS Certificate issued in favour of a candidate by the erstwhile authorities as mentioned vide said P&AR Department Notification may also be allowed if found valid.]

b) For S.C., S.T. and O.B.C. (non creamy layer) candidates:

- (i) In the district, the Sub-Divisional Officer of the Sub-Division concerned, and
- (ii) In Kolkata, the District Magistrate, South 24-Parganas or such Additional District Magistrate, South 24-Parganas, as may be authorized by the District Magistrate, South 24-Parganas, on behalf and the District Welfare Officer, Kolkata and Ex-officio Joint Director, Backward Classes Welfare.

c) For Persons with Benchmark Disabilities:

- (i) Medical Board constituted at Government Medical College Hospitals in Kolkata, District Hospitals and Sub-Divisional Hospitals as per extant provisions laid down in RPwD Acts and rules.
- (ii) Certificate (APPENDIX-I) regarding Physical Limitation in an Examinee to write (required for only PwBD Candidates who opt for Scribe and /or Compensatory Time) from the Chief Medical Officer/ Medical Superintendent of a Government Health Care Institution.

d) For Ex-Servicemen:-

The claim of a candidate for being considered as an Ex-Serviceman should be supported by a certificate from the Army/ Air Force/ Naval Headquarters indicating therein the date of his/her joining the Armed Forces, the period of his / her service and the date of his/her release from the Armed Forces or the date of the completion of the period of his/her service requisite for being entitled to be released or transferred to the reserve.

e) For Meritorious Sportspersons:-

Competent Authorities for issuing Certificates to Meritorious Sportspersons are as follows:-

International Competition	Secretary of the National Federation/National Association of the Sports concerned.
National Competition	Secretary of the State Association of the Sports concerned.
Inter-University Tournament	Dean/Director of Sports or other Officer in overall charge of Sports of the University concerned.
National Sports/Games for School Education	Director or Deputy Director in overall charge of Sports/Games for Schools in the Directorate of School Education, West Bengal.

N.B: Area of competition other than mentioned above shall not be considered for granting MSP Status. Meritorious Sportspersons in the area of International Competition, National Competition Inter-University Tournament and National Sports/Games for School Education in the following list of Sports are eligible to apply for the posts meant for MSP quota:-

(i) Athletics (including Track and Field events), (ii) Badminton, (iii) Basket Ball, (iv) Cricket, (v) Football, (vi) Hockey, (vii) Swimming, (viii) Table Tennis, (ix) Volley Ball, (x) Tennis, (xi) Weight Lifting, (xii) Wrestling, (xiii) Boxing, (xiv) Cycling, (xv) Gymnastics, (xvi) Judo, (xvii) Rifle Shooting, (xviii) Kabaddi, (xix) Kho-Kho and (xx) Archery - vide Govt. of West Bengal, Labour Department vide Notification No. 49 -EMP/1M - 25/98 dated 1st March, 2011 read with Notification No. Labr./209 - Emp dated 21st September, 2016.

11. The Public Service Commission may require such further proof of particulars from the candidates as it may consider necessary and may make enquiries about their character and other particulars regarding suitability and eligibility.
12. EWS, S.C., S.T., O.B.C. (NON CREAMY LAYER) OR PERSON WITH DISABILITY CERTIFICATE MUST BE OBTAINED WITHIN THE CLOSING DATE OF RECEIPT OF APPLICATIONS AND NO CLAIM IN THIS REGARD WILL BE ENTERTAINED AFTERWARDS. IN CASE A CANDIDATE IS UNABLE TO PRODUCE THE RELEVANT CERTIFICATE IN SUPPORT OF THE DECLARATION/CLAIM MADE BY THE CANDIDATE AT THE TIME OF DOCUMENT VERIFICATION, HIS/HER CANDIDATURE WILL BE SUMMARILY REJECTED.
13. (a) O.B.C. (Non Creamy Layer) candidates must submit their renewed / revalidated O.B.C. (Non Creamy Layer) certificate prior to interview and at the time of appointment.
(b) EWS candidates must submit their renewed/ revalidate Income & Asset Certificate (in prescribed format given in Annexure-C) prior to interview and at the time of appointment.

14. Candidates must fulfill the essential qualifications by the closing date.
15. All requisite certificates regarding educational qualifications, proof of age, other relevant experience certificates and other requisite documents must be furnished as and when required by the Commission.
16. If at any stage even after issue of a letter of recommendation for appointment a candidate is found ineligible in terms of the advertisement his/her candidature will be cancelled without further reference to him/her.

17. CANVASSING IN ANY FORM WILL DISQUALIFY THE CANDIDATURE.
18. In case of screening test, the candidates must abide by the instruction as may be given by Supervisors/Invigilators of the Examination. If the candidate fails to do so or indulges in disorderly or improper conduct, he/she will render himself/herself liable to expulsion from the Examination Hall and/or such other punishment as the Commission may deem fit to impose.
19. A candidate who has been reported against by the Supervisor of the Examination Centre for Violating any of the instructions will be punished with cancellation of candidature of the examination related to this advertisement and also debarment from future examinations and selections as may be decided by the Commission according to the circumstances of the case.
